



YOUR GUIDE TO OBTAINING AN ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

There are three primary utility providers that supply electrical power in Ras Al Khaimah. They are the Federal Electricity and Water Authority (FEWA), Utico and Al Ghail Power LLC. Below is a simple step-by-step guide designed to walk you through the process of connecting your electricity through the power provider that fits your needs.

APPOINT A FEWA-LICENSED CONSULTANT

Your first step is to appoint a consultant from a list of FEWA-authorized consultants. Your consultant will prepare the following:

1. Drawings for lighting
2. Power layout
3. Calculation of load
4. Single line diagram
5. Setting layout plan

OBTAIN APPROVALS ON THE DRAWINGS

Once the drawings are prepared, your consultant will submit the drafts to RAK FTZ for preliminary approval. After RAK FTZ's approval, your consultant will submit the drawings to FEWA for the final approval.

INSTALL ELECTRICAL WIRING

After the final approval on the drawings has been obtained, your contractor can begin installing the electrical wiring and complete a RAK FTZ electrical connection form.

OBTAIN A NO-OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) FROM RAK FTZ FOR THE ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

After completion of the electrical wiring, you can request an electricity connection NOC from RAK FTZ, addressed to FEWA. The NOC can be requested via email at sc@rakftz.com or via phone at +971 7 204 11 11

SUBMIT DOCUMENTATION TO FEWA

After receiving the NOC, you will submit the following documents to FEWA in order to set up an appointment for electrical connection:

1. NOC from RAK FTZ
2. Documents and drawings stamped by contractor
3. Drawing approval from FEWA
4. Passport copy and Emirates ID
5. Trade licence & lease agreement with RAK FTZ

SUBMIT DOCUMENTATION TO RAK FTZ

After completion of the electrical wiring, you will submit the following documents to RAK FTZ:

1. Documents and drawings stamped by contractor
2. Drawing approval from FEWA
3. Passport copy and Emirates ID
4. Trade licence & lease agreement with RAK FTZ
5. An official letter on company letterhead addressed to RAK FTZ, requesting an NOC for laying 11KV cable from the power utility to the location

COLLECT NOC AND SUBMIT TO POWER PROVIDER

After receiving the NOC from RAK FTZ, you can submit it to the power provider to set up an appointment for electrical connection.
